Port Operations Update #4 Regarding Christiana Avenue Fire

(Wilmington, Del.) – The City of Wilmington's Emergency Management announced that all fires on 610 Christiana Avenue are under control and being contained. Wilmington Fire Department will be on the scene for the next 24 hours or as necessary.

Ship discharging operations at the Port of Wilmington fully resumed this morning. Terminal truck loading operations are set to resume at 13:00 hours today.

Traffic on Christiana Ave is still limited with previously communicated detours still in effect. Traffic on Terminal Avenue, the main route into the Port, has remained open and unaffected by the fire event.

This will be the last update from the Diamond State Port Corporation absent any significant changes to the fire event wrap-up.
